The thriving, young community of Nibley City in Cache County is seeking qualified and driven Recreation Specialists to help build a Happy, Healthy, Connected Community. Specialists will be paid a percentage of the revenue from an assigned youth sports program and or other revenue generating programs as assigned. Recreation specialists receive a single payment upon completion of the assigned program once it is completed as outlined.

Position Overview

Under the supervision of the Recreation Director, and or Recreation Coordinator the recreation specialist will implement a youth recreation program. Opportunities may include: Pickleball Instructor, Cross-Country Coach, SUPER START Soccer and SUPER START T-ball programs (Please specify program interests in a submitted application) Depending on the specialist's experience, other opportunities may exist within the Recreation Department.

Essential Functions

Specialists facilitate recreation programs, instruct participants, parents and, as applicable, others; request and respond to participant feedback. They effectively communicate verbally and through electronic means with all parties involved with the program and ensure that all associated equipment is ready for use. Some programs require specialists to take attendance, process progress reports and complete equipment inventories.

Duration, Schedule & Expectations

- Specialists must be available for the duration of a program.
- 2-6 hours per week depending on the program.
- Most programs are held in the evenings on a weekday(s) or early mornings in the summer.

Preferred Skills

- Experience instructing children in youth sports or other recreation activities.
- Experience working with parents of young children.
- Knowledge of any of the following: soccer, baseball, softball, pickleball, distance running
- An interest in empowering youth through recreation

Physical/Environmental Factors

This work requires some lifting of heavy objects and boxes, work outdoors, set up and take down. Work includes contact with the public and requires exceptional customer service skills.

Pre-assignment testing and other requirements

Prior to appointment, the applicant will be required to successfully pass a criminal background check. Possession of a valid driver's license is required, and an ability to drive a Nibley city truck and trailer may be required for some programs.
