Lightning Rule:

In the event that lightning is seen and or thunder heard the Umpire and Coaches will stop the game and clock to check the (FREE) Weather Bug Phone App to determine the proximity of lightning. (Use the Menu top left corner to select the lighting feature). If lightning is detected within 6 miles or less, players and spectators will be asked to take cover in vehicles. The Umpire will confirm that the score-books are up to date and match, the game will resume after 20 min if there is no lightning within 6 miles of the ballpark. Bylaws regarding inclement weather apply to lightning.



Rain-outs: Plan on a game unless otherwise notified by Nibley City no matter what the forecast may be. In the event that significant rain is falling and or field conditions are unsafe due to inclement weather Nibley City Recreation will call a rain-out by 4 pm the day of the game. You will be notified by: a text or phone call from our Recreation Department.

If the coaches agree the weather is too bad to play, a fifteen-minute waiting period will be implemented to see if the weather clears before canceling the game. If the game gets canceled due to weather, contact Nibley City Recreation the same day to request a rescheduled game.

Rescheduled Games: will only occur when Nibley City or the Coaches cancel the games due to weather/field conditions. Forfeit games will not be rescheduled. Coaches are encouraged to use players from the league below to facilitate a game.
