Question 3

Under bullet point 2.5 it requests survey mapping of the canals. Is this to be mapping grade or survey grade

Response 3

The intent of surveying/mapping canals is two-fold:

- a. Provide map grade detail of canal systems
- b. Determine the capacity of canals

The consultant should plan to collect adequate levels of survey and mapping information to accomplish objectives.

Question 4

If the purpose is to develop information to determine flow capacities of the canals, how robust does the survey need to be in terms of frequency of cross sections and details on canal splits and junctions?

Response 4

The consultant should plan to collect adequate levels of survey and mapping information to accomplish objectives.

Question 5

Do we need to chase these canals beyond city limits to verify capacities to the end of the respective systems?

Response 5

There is a certain amount of information necessary to evaluate capacity of systems within and beyond city limits. Nibley city does not want to master plan a stormwater system that will adversely impact neighboring communities. The consultant should plan to collect and analyze enough information to accomplish objectives.

Do you have an estimate of the length of canals that will need to be surveyed to complete this project?
