### FACTS THAT ARE GOOD TO KNOW NOW THAT YOU LIVE IN NIBLEY CITY

- When you have moved, you will need to notify the Driver License Division of your new address within 10 days: contact www.driverlicense.utah.gov, or go to the Driver's License Office at 110 East 700 South in Logan, 752-0332, to change your address. There is a \$50 fine for non-compliance.
- Please use SOUTH and EAST/WEST when listing your address on ALL City correspondence. This is also preferred by the Logan City Post Office. We want an emergency vehicle to be able to find you as quickly as possible, should you ever have that need.
- All dogs, both inside and out, need to be licensed with Nibley City within 30 days of residency. Failure to license your dog(s) will result in a citation. Dogs do not have to be licensed until they are 6 months of age.
- There is a leash law in Nibley City. If your dog(s) are off your property, they need to be on a leash.
- Winter parking hours are from November 1 to April 1. You cannot park on the street overnight. **This is enforced whether or not there is snow**.
- If you have a home business, you may apply for a Business License/Conditional Use Permit at the City Office.
- Nibley City does shut off your water service for delinquent utility accounts. You will receive notice of this on your utility bill, \$50 Reconnect Charge due prior to the water being turned back on. It is against the law to turn the water on yourself, once it has been shut off by Public Works.
- If you choose to be on Equal Pay you must make the payment every month. If you miss two months of payment the system will automatically delete you from further equal payments and the full amount will be due.
- Prior to installing a sprinkler system please call for the water pressure and size of the service. A backflow protector is required.
- A permit is required before installing a fence, building, or putting a shed on your property. Applications are available at the City Office. If you have any questions, please contact the City before you begin any work.
- The Cache Valley Transit District serves Nibley and we have maps at the City showing the different routes and times. There is no charge to ride the bus. You can also visit www.cvtdbus.org for additional information.
- The City has an Annual City Celebration "Heritage Days" the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of June. This is a great time to renew old friendships and form new ones! The Committee Chair is always looking for volunteers who are enthusiastic about the City and eager to have a good time and meet lots of other people.
