# Questions/Answers January 22, 2024

### Question 1

While not explicitly listed, is the Well Drilling CM included in the scope so that we can get the well drilled, constructed and tested before finalizing the well house design?

### Response 1

The City is looking forward to working with the selected consultant team to help determine the most appropriate tasks necessary to complete the Objectives of the RFP. Initial assumptions can be made by reference to existing source capacity of each of the City's wells, available on the City's website within the Nibley City Culinary Water Master Plan.

#### **Question 2**

With several of the tank sites in the attached exhibit shown down in the valley, is it the City's intent to boost directly off the tank into the system for pressure?

#### Response 2

The City is looking forward to working with the selected consultant team through the City's water model to explore options and preferred alternatives.

### Question 3

With the well being right at the tank, is the City interested in treating with Chlorine in the tank?

### Response 3

The City prefers chlorination at the source but we are open to other viable treatment options.

Has the City previously explored any funding options that they are interested in pursuing.

#### Response 4

The City has not pursued any funding opportunities at this time and is looking forward to working with the selected consultant to help guide us on options and availability of funding sources.
