League Motto Support:

Leagues:

- Based on the players grade in school (2024-2025)
- 1st-2nd grade league
- 3rd-4th grade league
- 5th-6th grade league
- 7th-9th grade league

Registration includes:

- Football Jersey
- 8 games/scrimmages (weather permitting)
 - One of these games will be a special game experience (near the end of season)
- Practices based on coach availability

*Required Equipment (not provided):

- Athletic shorts or pants with a drawstring and NO POCKETS
- A mouthguard (recommended, not required)
- Cleats are recommended but not required. NO METAL CLEATS
- *Team equipment including flags, balls, cones, whistle etc. will be issued to the coach

Locations:

Games: will be held at City Hall, Anhder Park, Elkhorn Park and Heritage Park in Nibley. Games will also be played in Wellsville at Darley Field and in Hyrum at the East Park Softball Field

Practices: will be held at parks throughout Nibley, Hyrum, and Wellsville as scheduled by the coaches. This program is open to residents in the South part of Cache Valley. If there are enough players and coaches to form a team representing a given City or geographical area we have done so for the convenience of practices for teams in their respective towns.

Game Days (all evening games may be subject to change)

- 1st-2nd grade league: Tue and Thur
- 3rd-4th grade league: Mon and Wed
- 5th-6th grade league: Mon and Thur
- 7th-9th grade league: Wed and Thur

(NO FRIDAYS OR SATURDAYS)

Rules:

Players are required to wear their jersey on the outside (if wearing additional cold weather clothing and must be TUCKED IN to their pants/shorts. The field markings and rules are based on the NFL flag program with some modifications, with possible minor field size modifications based on available space. Similar to the NFL flag program a small team format with 6 v 6 or similar will be used to maximize play time and player experience with the ball.

Games/Scrimmages & Officiating:

Since our objective is to offer an affordable developmental program with a football experience where participants can learn the basics in a non-competitive environment, games will be more of a scrimmage format with the coaches officiating and teaching players throughout the scheduled time frame. (However, a referee will help coaches manage the 5th-6th & 7th-9th grade games)
